AAPL Regional Director's Report

The June 2012 Board Meeting of the AAPL was held at the Hilton Union Square in San Francisco, California on Wednesday, June 13, 2012. Attendance for the Annual Meeting was pegged at a record 1,429. A wonderful combination of tours, social events, and educational seminars was arranged by AAPL and the Annual Meeting Chairman, Greg Zerkel.

As you will see below, AAPL continues its diligent efforts to promote the interests of its membership as to education, professionalism and defending against attempts to impede our tradition of self-regulation. The following is my report:

The Leg-Reg Committee has been very busy on all fronts and parts of the nation but particularly in Appalachia where efforts to regulate or license landmen have popped up in Pennsylvania, Maryland, New York and Ohio. The latter two states have had legislation introduced and AAPL will be actively participating with other industry representatives to oppose this legislation.

I participated in a telephone conference recently with representatives from OOGA, NALA and with Marty Schardt of AAPL among others to address some unfavorable legislation that has been brought forward in Ohio. If we are successful in combatting this legislation, all landmen whether or not they are members of AAPL will benefit.

- The Tax Issues group is working to amend the Workmen's Compensation statutes in a number of states to assure that landmen are, in most instances, classified as independent contractors. Pennsylvania is one of the group's target states.
- Final Winter NAPE results are in. There were 17,000 registrants. Summer NAPE looks to be, on historic trends, about 1/3 the size of Winter NAPE. Space at Winter NAPE 2013 is down to fewer than 100 booths remaining and with a high level of sponsorship. NAPE East which will be held in Pittsburgh is coming together. The first top level sponsor is EQT.

I am sorry that I will be unable to attend the July meeting but look forward to seeing everyone in Pittsburgh in August.
